

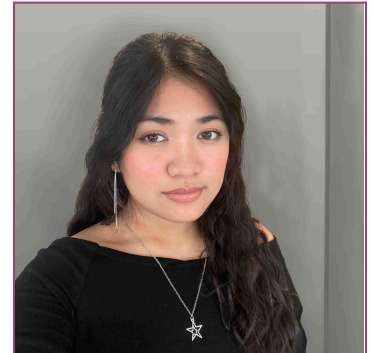

A Rising Star in Math Education

Quinn Cantor joined Wildewood Education in 2025 as a Lead Math Tutor, and already leads AP Calculus AB and Geometry classes for Wildewood's homeschool students, tutors middle and high schoolers in math up to AP Calculus, and helps students prepare for the SAT, ACT, and independent-school admissions tests including the ISEE and SSAT. Even early in her career, Quinn has built a reputation for pairing academic rigor with genuine warmth in the way she teaches.



A Deep Well of Classroom Experience

Even before joining Wildewood, Quinn built an unusually broad base of teaching experience. As a student teacher at Fenway High School, she led two Precalculus classes with junior and senior students and supported a mentor teacher's Algebra II sections. At the University of Massachusetts Boston, she spent more than two years tutoring through the university's Subject Tutoring Program — working with students across Quantitative Reasoning, College Algebra, Precalculus, Managerial Calculus, Survey of Calculus, Calculus I, Calculus II, and Linear Algebra — and served as a Tutor-Mentor for the university's Early College program, supporting a professor's College Algebra class and staffing student support blocks for homework help and quiz review.

A Passion for Math Education Beyond the Classroom

Quinn's interest in math education extends beyond tutoring itself. As a Math Intern with EdVestors, she collaborated with the organization's Math Director to create the first-ever EdVestors Math Memo and supported research into math education best practices. She has also interned in the University of Massachusetts President's Office, assisting with administrative projects and research.

Academic Excellence

Quinn graduated from the University of Massachusetts Boston's Honors College in 2025 with a Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics and a minor in UTeach STEM Education, earning a 3.90 GPA. She was named to the Dean's Academic List seven consecutive semesters, received the Honors College's Classroom Leadership Award three times, and had an essay published in UMass Boston's undergraduate journal, Undercurrents.
